Join us for a simple meal and fellowship after the walk around 5:30 PM, at Christ United Church of Christ (corner of Market and Center Streets).

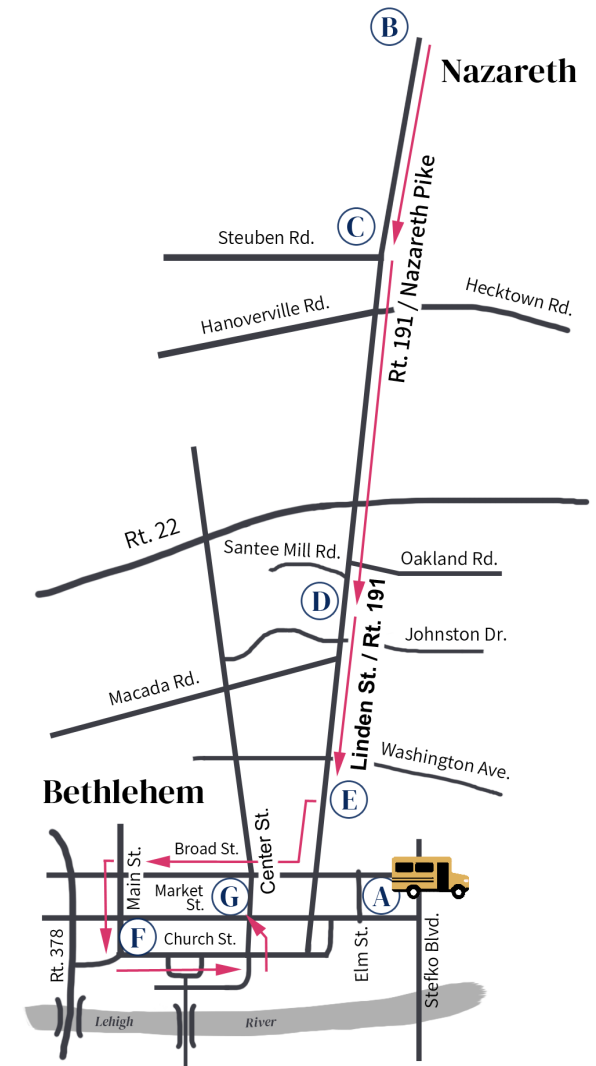
## Suggestions
